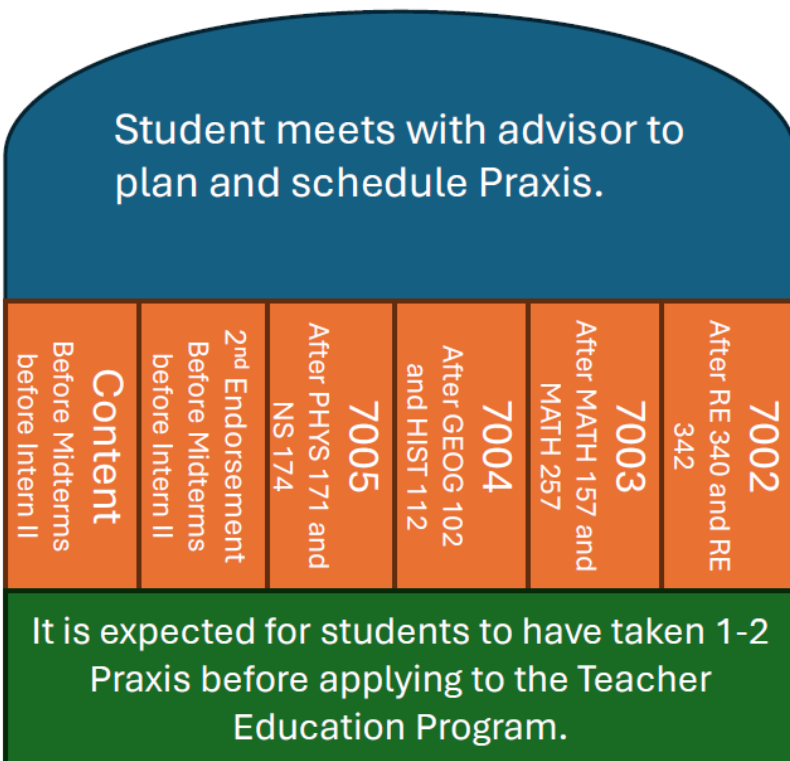


Praxis Information 2026-2027



INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

For Elementary Education majors: all 4 elementary subtests must be taken and passed by **midterms** of the semester before you enter Internship I (ED-426). The praxis for your minor/second endorsement must be taken and passed before entering Internship II (ED-429).

For Secondary Education majors: all content area exams for all endorsements must be passed by **midterms** of the semester prior to entering your internship (ED-460 or ED-461).

If you do not pass your praxis, there is a waiting

period before you can retake a test. **Be sure to plan ahead and give yourself plenty of time to complete your tests.** Please see your advisor or email education@lcsc.edu with any follow up questions.

When to take the PRAXIS tests:

TEST	Take As Soon As You Complete...
#7002 Teaching Reading (Elementary)	RE 340 and RE 342
#7003 Math (Elementary)	MATH 157 and MATH 257
#7004 Social Studies (Elementary)	HIST 111 or HIST 112 and/or POLS 101
#7005 Science (Elementary)	PHYS 171 and NS 174 (on campus) or BIOL 100 and CHEM 100 (online)
Minor Area (Elementary)	all Minor Courses – take during Internship I
Content Area (Secondary)	Take during the semester before student teaching

ED-250 PRAXIS PREPARATION FOR ELEMENTARY TEACHER CANDIDATES 1.00 Credit

Preparation for the State-required Praxis subject tests for elementary teaching candidates. The required subject area tests consist of assessments in Reading & Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science. Candidates will practice test taking skills and engage in content area materials. Only available if 9+ students enroll.

- **Practice exams** can be found through the LCSC Library's subscription to the Learning Express Library. To access these free practice exams, first go to the LCSC Library's website and click on the A-Z databases link. Then search for "Learning Express Library." In the search bar of the Learning Express Library, search for the praxis test you want to practice for (ex. "Praxis 7004"). Then, sign in or register to create a free account.

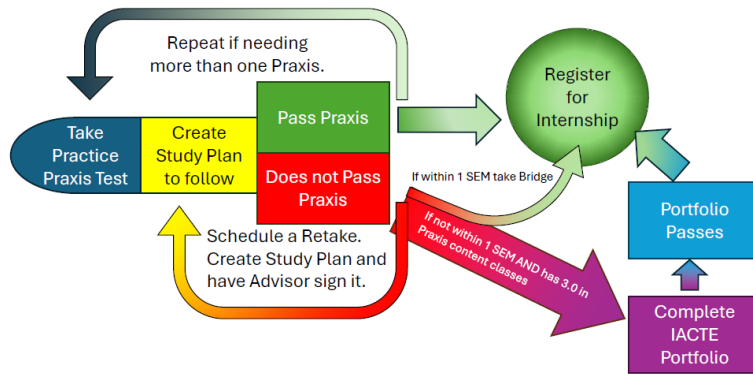

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Praxis Pathways



PRAXIS RETAKE

There is a waiting period before you are able to retake a Praxis Exam. You must create a study plan with your advisor before the new date.

If you score within 1 standard error of measurement you may qualify for the Bridge,

depending on the test. You also qualify to submit a portfolio, regardless of the test. If you do not score within 1 standard error of measurement you can qualify to turn in a portfolio after you have attempted the test one more time.

PRAXIS BRIDGE

Praxis Bridge is an alternate passing option offered to teacher candidates when they've come close to—but not quite reached—a passing score on their Praxis exam. Instead of retaking the entire test, eligible candidates can complete a learning module to demonstrate their competency and receive a passing score. ETS will send an email to qualified candidates.

IACTE PORTFOLIO

An alternative content assessment pathway that adds flexibility and reduces barriers to certification is the praxis portfolio. The portfolio is an opportunity for teacher candidates who have shown that they would make a well-started teacher, but they cannot pass the Praxis due to a learning disability, test anxiety, length of time away from content, affordability/cost, or other unforeseen circumstances. This pathway is intended for those candidates who are very near program completion. See your advisor for a praxis portfolio template.
